#### Understanding the World

Our focus area for this half term is *Understanding the World*. We are exploring different life cycles such as sunflowers and caterpillars. This links in with our focus book *The Very Hungry Caterpillar by Eric Carle*. We have our own caterpillars in Pre-School and we will be watching them change into butterflies. We enjoyed a visit from Millers Farm where we were be able to have close encounters with donkeys, pigs, goats & sheep. The Pre-School children joined the rest of the Federation in celebrating the King's Coronation. We took part in activities and performed some songs at the Coronation Tea Party on Thursday 4<sup>th</sup> May, and then on the Friday children were invited to wear non-uniform, colourful, celebratory clothes.
