90.6% of parents who responded said that they find the E-Safety Newsletter useful.

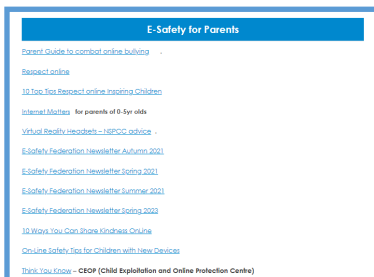
All children asked said they know that they should be respectful online.
