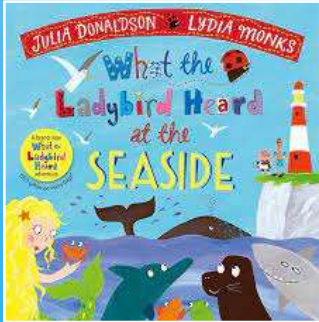




Topic Overview

Literacy



Our focus this half term is Literacy. Our focus book is What the Ladybird Heard at the Seaside by Julia Donaldson. We will be learning the story and talking about the rhyming words. We will be looking at key parts of a book such as the title, front cover and text.

Our September School starters have now started Read Write Inc. sessions and they will continue to learn new sounds each week. There will be many summer related activities offering opportunities to explore letters, sounds and mark making.
