Keep practising Reading through listening to stories, reading stories and keywords and looking for print in the local environment.

They will also have opportunities to investigate scientific ideas during their Busy Time.

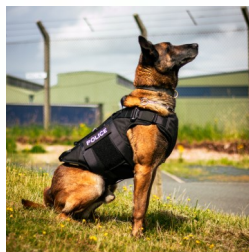
