This term we will be working hard on our story telling skills and our focus will be literacy. For this we will have lots of opportunities to read books and stories and to dress up as our favourite characters.

In **Literacy**, after the pantomime of Cinderella, we will be learning the story. We will also be reading other traditional tales such as The Three Little Pigs, The Three Billy Goats Gruff and many others.

Ideas for home:

Ask your child to talk about what time of day different things happen, eg "I clean my teeth AFTER my breakfast." "I get up at 7 o'clock in the morning."

Encourage your child to practise forming letters using the RWI sheets sent home. Make simple words using your letters. Make simple sentences using your those words.

Encourage your child build their core strength and confidence- eg swing on some monkey bars, go down a fireman's pole, RUN!!
