Personal Social & Emotional Development: Kindness & Transition



We are focussing on kindness this half term. We will be encouraging the children to look after others, help their friends, share toys and wait their turn to talk. We will look at how different scenarios could make us feel.


The children will be encouraged to recognise these emotions in themselves and in others.

We have lots of lovely activities booked in with Year R to help support our school starters with their transition. As well as Parent Stay & Play visits, we will be joining Year R for joint Welly Walks and Big Play. The Year R staff will be visiting us in Pre-School and the children will also visit the Year R classrooms to explore their exciting resources.
